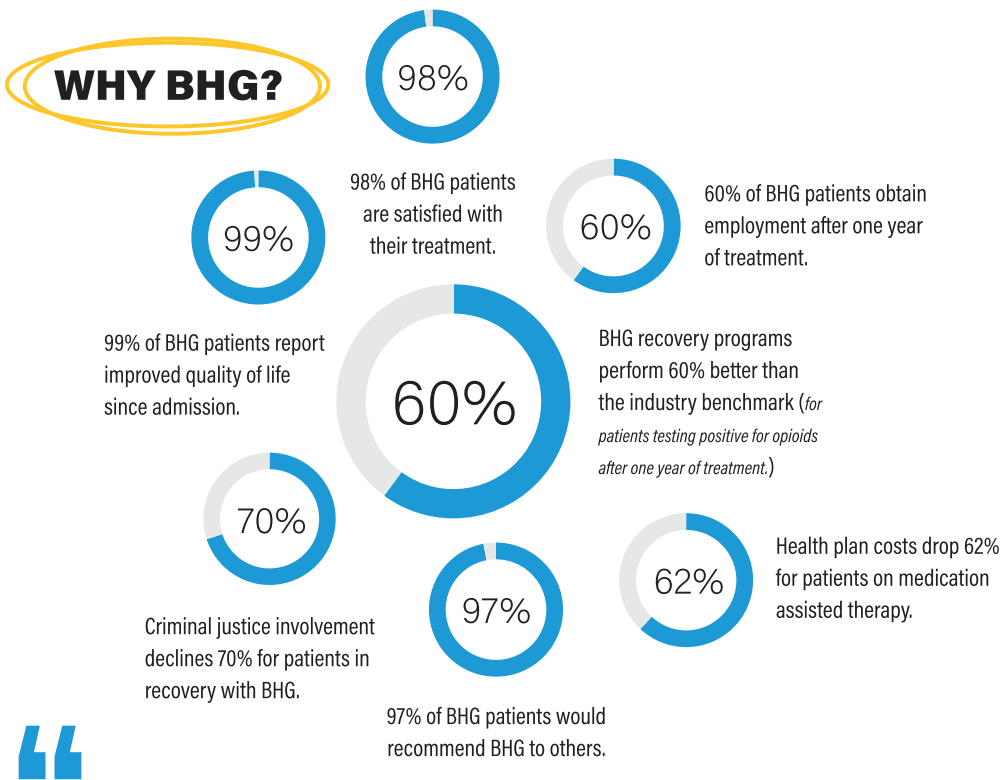
OUR PURPOSE: Renewal.

We leverage the full spectrum of evidence-based substance use recovery care to tailor treatment to the unique needs of each patient. Our approach to personalized treatment and recovery care restores lives, strengthens families and rejuvenates the communities in which we serve.

Focus on recovery

At BHG, we focus on real recovery, not just treatment. Our medical mission is to empower our patients to realize their best level of functioning in the community. Our recovery care teams include highly-trained physicians, counselors, nurses, and support staff all working with patients on their unique recovery journey.

MAT-based programs use FDA-approved medication as a stabilizing factor while administering comprehensive treatment services, including individual and family counseling. Medications have been shown in controlled trials to be superior to counseling alone, helping patients with opioid use disorder abstain from opioid use and stay in treatment. MAT also reduces the likelihood of an overdose in the case of a relapse.



Recovery from addiction is an active process of continual growth that addresses the biological, psychological, social and spiritual disturbances inherent in addiction. — ASAM

Early Intervention

Individuals addicted to opioids who only receive psychological support are 2x more likely to suffer a fatal overdose than those (also) treated with medication.

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Outpatient OTP with IOP

MAT bridges the biological and behavioral components of addiction and is the most effective treatment for OUD, (e.g., greater reduction in illicit drug use, criminal activity, and mortality). In fact, methadone is listed among "essential medications" by the WHO.

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Office-Based Services

Clinicians can prescribe only two of the three FDA-approved medications for OUD and no counseling is required to support behavioral modification or co-occurring conditions.

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Residential / Inpatient Services

Greater than 80% relapse rate in the year following treatment with a high risk for overdose and death when relapse occurs.

Per SAMHSA, this should not be a stand-alone treatment.
